Athey Over Cranberry Creek
During Culvert Replacement 2018, Hamilton Township

Removed the 3 existing 24" diameter corrugated metal pipe culverts and replaced with a 48' L x 12' W x 5' H concrete box culvert to allow greater passage of aquatic life.



Stockwell Over Middle Branch Cedar River
After Streambank Stabilization 2018, Hamilton Township

Stabilized the streambank using rip rap and added millings on top of the roadway to reduce soil erosion.
