Athey Over Cranberry Creek
*During Culvert Replacement
2018, Hamilton Township*

Removed the 3 existing 24" diameter corrugated metal pipe culverts and replaced with a 48' L x 12' W x 5' H concrete box culvert to allow greater passage of aquatic life.



Stockwell Over Middle Branch Cedar River
*After Streambank Stabilization 2018,
Hamilton Township*

Stabilized the streambank using rip rap and added millings on top of the roadway to reduce soil erosion.
