## Right of Way!

### What is it?:

A Michigan road right-of-way (ROW) is the land that includes the road, shoulders, ditches, and adjacent land from a road. The ROW is typically 66 feet wide, with 33 feet on either side of the road's center line. However, the width can vary in certain situations.

### What's its purpose?:

The ROW supports space for pedestrians, leaving cars, and all roadside utilities such as gas lines, electrical lines, storm drainages, and fiber optics.

If you need to work within the ROW, call the Clare County Road Commission at 989-539-2151 to see whether a permit is needed to work within your ROW. Permit costs are usually low.

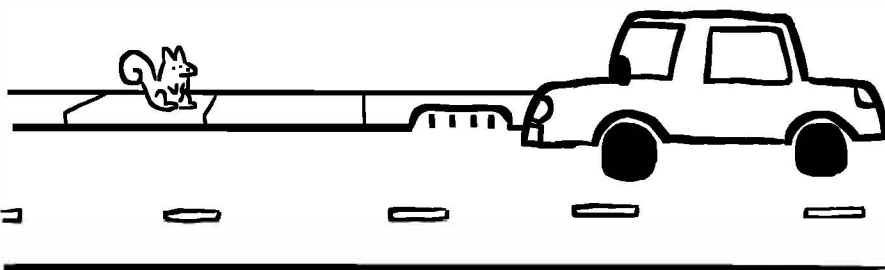

## ORV on Paved Road

DO stay on far right side of maintained road.



DO NOT drive on unmaintained shoulder.

YEILD for other vehicles by STOPPING on shoulder of the road.



## ORV on Unpaved Road

DO stay on maintained road when driving.



DO NOT drive on unmaintained shoulder.

YEILD for other vehicles by staying on far right side of the road.
